Financial Report

Operating Fund:	<u>April</u>	Year to Date	% of Annual Budget
Income	\$67,475	\$289,332	36%
Expense	<u>\$70,634</u>	<u>\$229,789</u>	29%
Net	(\$3,159)	\$59,543	



At the end of April we were \$59,543 in the black. In April we received \$217,212 toward the Building Fund. This includes the proceeds from the sale of the house a member gave to LPC. We were able to pay our mortgage of \$6,943 and an additional \$210,269 to pay down the mortgage. God is faithful!

Net	\$26,847	\$85,882	

In May, the Operating Fund ended \$85,882 in the black for the year.

The Building Fund received \$17,439 in May, and we were able to pay the mortgage payment of \$6,943 and an excess of \$10,496 toward our mortgage leaving a balance of \$458,208. Thank you for your continued commitment and support of LPC through your giving, time, and talents




