"Ask the Lord for rain in the spring, for He makes the storm clouds. And He will send showers of rain so every field becomes a lush pasture."
Zechariah 10:1

The people of the ancient world did not have elaborate sprinkler or irrigation systems. They didn't have water at the turn of a faucet or many of the modern conveniences that we almost unconsciously depend upon. For the most part, they were completely dependent on the rains for their livelihood. Without rain, they could not go on living. God instructed His people that He can provide the spring rains that they needed for their crops. He can make storm clouds of nourishing rain. The Lord challenged His people by telling them, "Put your trust in Me and depend on Me to provide for your needs. Ask Me, and I will answer your prayers. I will provide what I alone can provide. I will give you life."

In the same way, God desires us

to trust in Him. He tells us to call upon Him for our needs. He can make clouds of refreshing rain to water the parched places in our soul. He can provide the spiritual nourishment to help us become a lush pasture. He can send the sun and rain to help us flourish as individuals and as a church. Treasurer's Report - Carol Bedell - December 2021/ January 2022

At the end of December we were \$64,368 in the black. During the closing of the 2021 books, we were able to pay an additional \$172,047 toward our CIF mortgage, leaving

a balance of \$738,155. We were also able to transfer excess funds to the Major Maintenance Restricted Fund, a newly created, one-time 2022 Maintenance Restricted Fund, and the Missionary Support – LPC Restricted Fund. Praise God!

In January, the Operating Fund ended \$10,795 in the black.

The Building Fund received \$17,917 in January, and we were able to pay the mortgage payment of \$6,943 and an excess of \$10,974 toward our mortgage. Thank you for your continued commitment and support of LPC through your giving and your talents.


